


# 2011 Census release: Ward profile E05000132 Fortune Green

March 2013

This profile provides information on key demographics, health care, household and employment status for this ward primarily based on the 2011 Census data. It shows both the differences between the Camden average and the ward, and where available, between the 2001 and 2011 Census figures. All data for 2011 were published by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) in January 2013. All data are available at www.ons.gov.uk. Unless otherwise stated, data are for 2011.


### **DEMOGRAPHICS**



In 2011 there were a total of 11,740 residents in Fortune Green, compared to 10,465 in 2001.


The 60-74 years age group saw the largest increase from 2001 (from 3% to 10%).

### **Marital and Civil Partnership status**



In 2011, 56% of residents in Fortune Green were recorded as not living in a couple. This is lower than Camden (59%) and is a decrease from the ward's percentage in 2001 (58%).

### Religion




The percentage of people with no religion in Fortune Green has increased from 23% to 24% since 2001, and is the same as in Camden (24%).

### **Ethnicity and Language**


### **Ethnic Group**

In 2011, 50% of people in Fortune Green were White British, followed by Other White, which represents 20% of the ward population.



### **Proficiency in English**

In 2011, 269 (2%) of people could not speak English or not speak English very well. This percentage is lower than in Camden overall (3%).




### Length of UK residency



The percentage of residents in Fortune Green that were born in the UK decreased from 64% in 2001 to 57% in 2011. The percentage of people born in EU countries (including the most recent accession countries) other than the UK and Ireland has increased from 6% in 2001 to 12% in 2011. The percentage of residents in Fortune Green who were not born in the UK but have lived in the country for ten years or more is higher in Fortune Green (22%) than in Camden (21%).


### **Employment by socio-economic group (NS-SEC)**



In 2011, 592 residents in Fortune Green were long-term unemployed or had never worked, which represents 6% of the ward population (compared to 7% in Camden).

Note: The working age population size does not exactly equal the sum of the individual categories due to rounding.

### **Economically inactive\* working age population (16-74)**



In 2011, there were 2,239 (24%) economically inactive residents\* in Fortune Green, of whom 339 (15%) were long-term sick or disabled (14% in Camden).

### **Education and qualifications**

In 2011, Fortune Green had a higher percentage of residents aged 16 or over with no qualifications than Camden, and a higher percentage of residents aged 16 or over with a degree level qualification than Camden.



### **HEALTH AND THE PROVISION OF UNPAID CARE**


Percentage of residents who rated their health as bad or very bad, Camden wards compared with Camden and London averages, 2011



5% of Fortune Green residents rated their health as 'bad' or 'very bad' in 2011, which was lower than Camden (6%). In 2001, 8% of Fortune Green residents rated their health as 'not good'.

87% of Fortune Green residents rated their health as 'good' or 'very good', which was higher than the Camden average (84%). 10% of Fortune Green residents rated their health as fair.

Residents who feel that they are limited by their health in their daily lives, Fortune Green compared with Camden.



### 6%

of Fortune Green residents felt that they were limited a lot in their daily lives, compared to 8% in Camden.

Note: The question from 2001 is not directly comparable with the 2011 question. In 2001, 14% of residents felt that they had a limiting long-term condition.






### LIVING ARRANGEMENTS

### Household size

278 (5%) households in Fortune Green had more than one person per room compared to 6% in Camden.

### Car ownership


2,897 (54%) households in Fortune Green had no access to a car or van in 2011 compared to 46% in 2001.




In 2011, 673 (22%) households in Fortune Green had a head of household aged 65 or over, compared to 24% in Camden.

891 (17%) households in Fortune Green lived in a property rented from the council or another social landlord, compared to 44% among households whose head was aged 65 or over, and 33% among all households in Camden.

### **Central heating**

185 (3%) households in Fortune Green had no central heating in 2011 compared to 8% in 2001. In 2011, the percentage of homes without central heating in Fortune Green was the same as Camden (3%).
